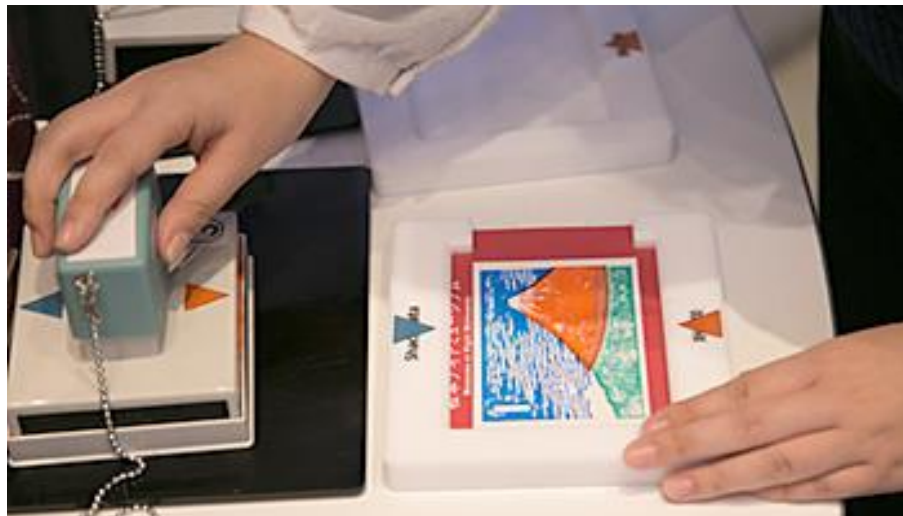


The taste differs by the type of rice, water, fermentation process, aging, temperature, and human.

SATOYAMA DESIGN FACTORY

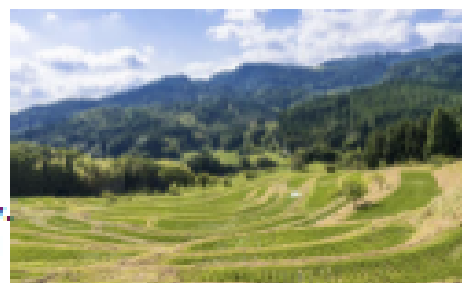
